<b>decide to (She decided to leave)</b>	<b>make (He made me cry)</b>	<b>avoid (She avoids speaking in public)</b>
<b>need to (I need to rest)</b>	<b>help (Can you help me carry this?)</b>	<b>keep (They keep talking)</b>
<b>plan to (We plan to travel)</b>	<b>hear (I heard her sing)</b>	<b>finish (He finished writing the report)</b>
<b>learn to (He learned to drive)</b>	<b>see (She saw him run)</b>	<b>mind (Do you mind opening the window?)</b>
<b>hope to (They hope to win)</b>	<b>feel (I felt the ground shake)</b>	<b>consider (They considered moving abroad)</b>
